Re: *Drainage District 88 Special Meeting October 25, 2012*

Dear Chairman Goetsch:

We recently received the proposed Drainage District Report which was prepared by Designtech Engineering, Inc. on August 18, 2012. Dennis Giese and other land owners who will receive the water to be discharged by the proposed district drains need more time to evaluate the proposal. The October 25, 2012 hearing needs to be adjourned for at least ninety (90) days to permit the parties sufficient time to evaluate the proposal.

We are very disappointed and concerned about the handing of this matter. As noted above, Mr. Prunuske's report is dated August 18, 2012. However, Mr. Giese did not receive a copy until September 28, 2012, and the Lake Sinnissippi Improvement District did not receive a copy at all.


The Circuit Court created District 88 under a series of conditions which were designed to assure that serious interests of the downstream owners were protected. The Order creating the District included those restrictions. Yet, this Report and design have been prepared with no input from Mr. Giese or the Lake District.

We have strenuously noted that the previous plans simply discharge the entire drainage onto Mr. Giese's property without provision for the impact the water has on his land. This Plan has a notation calling for "rock stabilization" of the outfall. However, the potential impact on Mr. Giese's property is very serious.

This hearing should be adjourned to permit the interested parties the full opportunity to evaluate the impact of the proposed plan on water quality and quantity.
